This infrared door release serves as both a standard exit release and an emergency release switch. Designed for contactless operation, it is easy to install and integrates seamlessly with the ACX Access Control System.

Unlike traditional door release mechanisms, this infrared release requires no physical pressure to function. Users can simply wave a hand in front of the sensor to activate it, triggering the internal relay to unlock the electronic lock.

Equipped with encrypted infrared technology, the device minimizes interference from other infrared remote controls. Additionally, it is unaffected by sunlight or external infrared sources, ensuring consistent and reliable performance.
